-2008-2013: From 2006-2010, Harambe was with No Pastor, no Shepard but still pulling together under the Lordship of Jesus Christ; 2010 Deacon Cottom becomes Church Administrator; 2010 Elder Anthony Sangster became pastor then later resigned in 2011; 2011-2013 being held together by Faith and Hope in Jesus Christ; Most ministries remained consistent and strong: Soup Kitchen-Richard Cottom and Sis Laverne, the Word of God is given along with a Hearty meal every week. Under the guidance of Sis Lorraine Beaton, Harambe become a partner with Greater Philadelphia Coalition Against Hunger and participates in the Walk Against Hunger where funds and grants can be or the needs of the Soup Kitchen; VBS-Bro Graham; Missions-Billie June Whitley.

-2007: 31st Anniversary Theme:" Continue the Vision and Complete the Assignment" Matt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:8, 2:42-46; Children Church started back up as a result of not many youth attending Sunday school; The Lord continued to give wisdom and direction to the Board of Directors and Deacons; The Triune God continued to lead the Congregation to steadfast. He continued to use them for His Glory.

Loving one another and praying for one another. Remaining Hot for the Lord! (Revelation 3:15-16) The Lord led Harambe's Missions Team to adopt the Sine-Kane Village in Mekhe W. Senegal. Team: Elder Richard Cottom, Bro. Herman Graham, Dea. Wallace Turner, Lorraine Beaton, Sis Billie June Whitley, Team Leader and Director.

- 2003-2006: Harambe adopts a Wolof people group in West Africa under the leadership of Sis Billie June Whitley; Block Party on Woodlawn St. sponsored by Harambe and Southern Baptist-450 people in attendance; Sis Pat Thomas initiated and hosted Women's Group Fellowships at her home; Sis Pat along with Sis Edith Milner worked with Harambe's youth with weekly Bible study; Over Comers Ministry began under the Leadership of Deacon Wingate; 19th Annual Missions Conference occurred; In 2006 the Dismissal of Rev Alston as Pastor; 2006 30th Anniversary Theme: "By Faith-No Limits, No Boundaries, Just Increase" Job 8:6-7, Heb. 6:10-15, 11:1-6

-2000-2002: For 2 years Harambe had guest Speakers and Ministers to preach on Sundays; Pastor Search committee was formed; July 2002 Rev Cleveland Alston and Darlene Alston were installed as Pastor and First Family of Harambe Baptist Church.

Early Years-Strengthening and Training:

The Lord set a path for Harambe to serve his eternal purpose and Pastor Theodore Johnson picked up his cross and answered when the Lord called him to serve in 1976 to lead Harambe and set the foundation for what God has in store. His eternal purpose, is Our Purpose! Harambe was birthed and sustained through the power of Prayer. He allowed us to be in several situations where we had to depend on Him completely. Pastor Johnson taught consistently that Prayer is the Work. When one

goes to God in Prayer, one must go in Faith. (Hebrews 1:6) We started with very few members, then grew to 200 and through the years down to a few again, and fewer. BUT GOD. Our lights, water, oil...Never shut off. Support for our missionaries never ceased. The Triune God taught us to trust and obey as He built the House on a firm foundation. For His Glory!

- -1987-1998: State Liquor Store next door to Harambe closed and was later purchased by Harambe; In 1990 and a few years beyond, Ministries continued to grow-Soup Kitchen, VBS, World Missions, Sunday School, Bible Study, Prayer Meetings, Praise and Worship, Usher Board, Men's Group and Outreach, Women's Group, and Deacon Board; 1995 Anniversary Theme: "Deny Yourself and Follow Me" Matt. 16:24-25; 1998 22nd Anniversary Theme: "Move In Unity-Continue the Vision"; Pastor Johnson begun a radio ministry on WTMR
- -1986: Celebrated 5 years of being on Chew Ave; Evangelism and Street Evangelism started under the leadership of Bro Herman Graham; Pastor Johnson and Harambe developed a special relationship with Chelten Baptist Church in Dresher, PA Pastor Glen Blossom, and became sister churches.
- 1981: 5th Anniversary Theme: "That all the people of the earth may know that the Lord is God and that there is none else" 1 Kings 8:60; Pastor Theodore Johnson, a Great Man of God, become full time Pastor with First Lady Mary Johnson by his side; Harambe moved to 5648 Chew Ave as a permanent dwelling place.

- -1976 The Journey begins: The Lord works within individuals first to fulfil His purpose. That is exactly what happened when a group of Christians corporately came together to form a new Branch of Zion. The Lord had already chosen His "Moses" and His "Joshua" for this particular Body of Christ. He gave Harambe "Moses" first! (He would later reveal "Joshua" in His time, the Right time)...To God be the Glory! Theodore Johnson, with the support of his Wife Mary Johnson, answered the call from the Lord to lead a unique body of believers and become Pastor (October 1976. The name "Harambe", Swahili for "pull together" was suggested by Richard Cottom. Harambe Baptist Church would meet to worship every Sunday in a Masonic Hall on Champlost St.
